



2017-2018 Tuition and Fees, Room, and Board (per semester)

Tuition Due Dates:

- Fall semester tuition is due August 1st each year
- Spring semester tuition is due December 15th each year
- Summer term tuition is due May 20th each year

Above dates are for pre-registered students. Pre-registered students are expected to pay any portion of their tuition, fees, room, and board that will not be covered by financial aid, scholarships, Voc Rehab, VA benefits, or a payment plan through Tuition Management Services by the due date shown.

Students who are not pre-registered and register after the due date for the semester should pay for classes on the day they register.

Student Responsibility for Charges:

The University of North Carolina at Asheville attempts to make sure each student is notified of charges to his/her student account. However, charges go on at various times throughout each semester depending upon when the student registers and the student's particular activity. **Failure to receive a billing statement does not relieve any student from financial responsibility for charges on their account. It is the student's responsibility to monitor their student account and to pay for any charges on their account in a timely manner.** Failure of the student to pay charges on their account may result in not being able to register for future classes, not being able to receive a transcript and being assessed late charges and interest on past due balances.

Student Health Insurance Requirement: \$1,270.00 per semester

Students who are degree seeking and taking 6 or more credit hours are required to have health insurance to attend a UNC system school. Those students will receive a semester charge of \$1,270.00 on their student account for the insurance. Students with existing health insurance coverage can waive out of the school insurance plan. Students must apply for the insurance waiver within 3 weeks of the beginning of the semester. For more information, visit the [Health & Counseling website](#).

Schedule Reinstatement Fee: \$100.00

Students who pre-register for classes but have their class schedule dropped for non-payment are subject to a \$100 fee for reinstatement of their class schedule. Payment of this fee does not guarantee the student will get the same schedule back. Schedule reinstatement is subject to class availability.

Late Graduation Application Fee: \$100.00

Students must submit an online application for graduation through their OnePort account by the appropriate deadline posted on the Registrar's [website](#). Students who do not submit the application by the deadline day will be required to pay a late application fee of \$100 prior to applying.

Orientation Fee: \$150.00

A one-time orientation fee charged to all new freshmen and transfer students. This is a non-refundable fee. New students are billed the orientation fee if they attend orientation and subsequently do not attend UNC Asheville.

Late Fees and Interest Charges on Past Due Accounts

Student accounts that become past due will be charged a Late Payment Fee of 10% of the past due portion of the account. In addition, once an account becomes past due interest shall accrue on the account and will be posted to the account each month. The interest rate will be determined according to the State of North Carolina General Statute 105-241.1(i) and is subject to change every six months.
